Wilderness Camp Facilities

Huckleberry, Cabins (Brookside, Hillside), Barn, Pavilion, Woodside

These rustic, yet comfortable accommodations offer an economical way to enjoy Spruce Lake. Huckleberry House is a 5 bedroom/3 bath log cabin that accommodates up to 26 people. The 7-room Barn is a bunkhouse that sleeps 36, and comes with a lounge as well as a guys & girls bathrooms. Hillside and Brookside cabins each have 6 bunk beds accommodating 12 people. The Woodside Bathhouse is available for groups using the cabins. The Pavilion offers a multi use area for meetings and dining, and has a large kitchen for preparing your own meals. Linens, pillows & towels are not available in any of the Wilderness Camp Facilities.

• Deposits are not refundable & are due with the signed contract to confirm the reservation.

3 Months Prior to Arrival Date

 Submit the 3 Month Update which allows groups the opportunity to adjust the number of rooms reserved and the projected number of people. There are no penalties to reduce the number of rooms, but cancellation of Mountain Lodges or Wilderness Camp Facilities will result in loss of deposit

3 Weeks Prior to Arrival Date

 Submit the 3 Week Update & projected Room List to reflect updated information on expected participants and to notify us of equipment needs, gym time, snack shop, gift shop or other requests.

Upon Arrival

- At check in, present the final Room List with the total number of participants for all meals, lodging or other services. Day guests should be included. The final bill is based on this information and is due at check in unless other arrangements have been made. The group is responsible to pay for additional people that were not included at check in.
- To allow for illness or emergencies, the Guaranteed Minimum is 80% of the Projected Total based on either the Contract, or the 3 Month Update if received three months prior to the arrival date.
- Maximum occupancy for accommodations is based on the number of bed spaces. Under certain circumstances, a 10% overage may be granted for an additional per person charge (which includes a mat & linens). If greater than 10%, additional rooms, when available, will be added to the reservation and final bill. If not available, the group is responsible for securing off site lodging.

Cancellations

- Cancellations three months prior to the arrival date result in loss of deposit.
- Meals, rooms, lodges and facilities (partial or full) cancelled within three months of the arrival date are subject to a cancellation fee of 80% of the Expected Total based on either the Contract, or the 3 Month Update if received three months in advance of the arrival date.

- Early check-in or late check-out of meeting rooms or lodges should be arranged in advance (may be subject to additional charges).
- Generally, groups have the first option of reserving the same facilities for the comparable weekend the following year (while still on site). However, dates may change due to calendar and holiday shifts.
- Adventure Programming (AP) & Extra Services requests should be submitted *at least 3 months in advance* to allow time for activity and staff scheduling. A short notice fee applies for Adventure Activities contracted within 3 weeks of the arrival date. Please provide expected number of participants for the activity at check in.
- Pets are not permitted.
- The use of Alcoholic Beverages is not permitted in any rooms, in any building, or anywhere on the grounds of Spruce Lake Retreat. Smoking is only permitted at the designated area on the north side of the Program Center.
- All areas are to be quiet by 11:00 pm. Pianos, PA systems or any other loud instruments should not be played after this hour. Please remind participants that running in the halls, doors opening and closing, and raised voices may disturb other guests trying to sleep.
- Children (up to age 11) must be supervised at all times.
- High standards of modesty are expected in your choice of attire. All guests are requested to keep their shirts on while in public areas on the Retreat Center property.
- Cooking is not permitted in rooms (except kitchenettes).
- Groups are responsible to pay for any damage to Spruce Lake facilities, equipment, or property and will be billed accordingly.
- The mission of Spruce Lake Retreat is to *Point People toward Christ.* Spruce Lake staff, along with its policies and guidelines, will promote Christian teaching, fellowship, recreation and nurture as we host your group.
