Owned and operated by the Franconia Mennonite Camp Association, Spruce Lake was founded in 1963 and has been a ministry of Christian Hospitality to hundreds of thousands of guest groups and individuals. Our ministries are Christ-Centered and include: **Outdoor School** for Christian Schools, **Program** Events for families, special needs groups, and individuals, a **Resident Wilderness Camp** for ages 7-18, and a **Day Camp** for ages 5-13.

We are a non-profit organization devoted to sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. Our Core Purpose is... "Pointing People toward Christ."

- □ In restoration with God through repentance and the shed blood and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, by grace through faith apart from works.
- That the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, effects the new birth, gives guidance in life, empowers for service, and enables perseverance in faith and holiness.
- □ That Jesus, when he lived on earth, revealed a way for people to live peacefully as devoted servants of God.
- That the church is the body of Christ, a people redeemed and striving to be obedient to the Word of God, in a fellowship of love, intercession, and healing.
- That the goodness of being single or married is honorable. We believe that God intends marriage to be a covenant between one man and one woman for life. According to Scripture, right sexual union takes place only within that heterosexual marriage relationship.
- That Jesus Christ will come again to gather his church, and judge all people. God will reign with Christ in justice, righteousness, and peace forever.

We will be transparent in our relationships, practices, and attitudes, including being honest with each other even when to do so may cause us or another initial pain.
