The EVS Housekeeping Lead, Trainer Inspector (Housekeeping LTI) ensures that the buildings are tidy, clean, and well-maintained through participation as a housekeeper and as housekeeping trainer, inspector, and supervisor. Housekeeping LTI is responsible for the initial, remedial and enhancement training of all housekeepers. The EVS Housekeeping LTI collaborates with the EVS Manager to implement strategies and action plans to improve effectiveness and performance outcomes for the housekeeping department.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Collaborates with EVS Manager and administration to ensure EVS Housekeepers are trained in the established methods of cleaning and sanitation.
- Collaborates with EVS Manager to routinely update housekeeping training manuals for clarity and effectiveness.
- Provide fundamental, remedial, and enhancement training for the housekeeping team.
 - o Welcome and orient new housekeepers.
 - o Conduct refresher courses and enhancement training for all housekeepers.
 - o Train the Trainers; train Housekeeping Lead/s in inspection functions to ensure consistent implementation of organization standards.
- Ensures guest buildings are clean, safe and in orderly condition.
 - Supervises and performs daily guest building cleaning duties and routine deep cleaning duties.
 - O Sweeps, mops, scrubs, or vacuums floors
 - o Gathers and empty trash; restocks supplies.
 - Cleans windows, mirrors and hard surfaces, dust and polish furniture, walls, and fixtures.
 - o Cleans, scrubs, sanitizes restroom floors, fixtures, mirrors, partitions etc.
