

## Spruce Lake & Pinebrook Study Camp Parent Agreement

I hereby enroll my child into Spruce Lake/Pinebrook Study Camp with the following understandings:

Study Camp is a ministry of Spruce Lake Retreat whose mission is "Pointing People toward Christ". Campers will be exposed to Biblical teaching on a regular basis during the day. Team members will respect beliefs of individual campers and families.

I give permission for my child to fully participate in all program activities.

I understand that I am responsible for providing all required school supplies (including a computer and headphones) and for communicating with my child's school/teacher and providing any necessary information to the Study Camp facilitators. Spruce Lake/Pinebrook is not responsible for lost or damaged school supplies.

Photographs and/or video of my child may be used for publicity purposes.

I give permission for my child to be transported by approved staff and vehicles if required.

Rules of conduct for campers, which will provide for a safe and life-enriching camper experience, will be clearly communicated to children and parents. We reserve the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's code of conduct.

Modest dress is required for boys & girls. See the What to Bring list for specific guidelines.

Campers are not permitted to carry cell phones or electronics during the day.

The deposit is non-refundable, and there are no daily rates or reductions if a camper does not attend all of the contracted days. No tuition will be returned for the weeks in which a camper is dismissed or withdrawn. Cancellations within two weeks of the registered week of camp are eligible for a refund of 50% of tuition. Cancellations/interruptions on or after the camp start date are not eligible for a refund.

Tuition is due by the Wednesday prior to the week of camp your child is attending. Any outstanding balance will be charged to the account on file.

There will be a \$25 fee for all returned insufficient fund checks.

In order for your child to participate, a health form must be completed and returned **prior to** attendance.

Only authorized persons (listed on registration form) will be permitted to pick up a camper from camp. Any changes or additions must be communicated to the camp office.

If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept home until they have been cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat), chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections.

The camp office should be contacted if your child will be absent due to illness.

In consideration of the permission granted for my child to participate in camp activities, I hereby release, and covenant with Spruce Lake and Pinebrook Retreat that I will never institute any action at law for any personal injuries, or injuries to property arising out of activities sponsored by Spruce Lake or Pinebrook Study Camp.
