- ❖ Packed Lunch, Snack & Water Bottle
- ❖ Cloth Face Mask – please label with camper’s name
- ❖ Computer **with login information & charger**
- ❖ Headphones
- ❖ School Supplies for Elementary Grades:
 - Crayons/Colored Pencils
 - Pencils, Sharpener & Eraser
 - Notebook
 - Scissors
 - Glue Stick
 - Folder to store papers
 - Book to read
- ❖ Hand Sanitizer
- ❖ Backpack
- ❖ Rainwear & Jacket / Sweatshirt
- ❖ Emergency Medications (inhaler, epi-pen, etc.)

What Not to Bring

Cell phones/ electronics, Non-prescription Meds, Drugs/ Alcohol/ Tobacco, Pocket knives, Weapons of any kind, Fireworks & combustibles.

Clothing Modesty

We encourage staff and campers to wear clothing that adheres to the modest standard described below. Please carefully look through your clothes to honor this request. If your attire is not modest, you will be asked to change. Please do not wear spaghetti-strapped tops, tank tops, mid-cut and short shirts, form-fitting shirts, short shorts, or leggings.

Suggested attire:

- Footwear: No flip flops or bedroom slippers. Shoes: Sneakers, Boots, Sandals with back strap, Clogs or Crocs
- Bottoms: Jeans or casual Docker style, Dress or casual Docker style shorts, Dress or casual capri style pants. Please refrain from wearing form fitting pants such as **leggings or yoga pants** for modesty reasons.
- Shirts/Tops: Clothing with **wording or images** contrary to the Christian principles of the camp is not appropriate.
- Dresses/Skirts: No shorter than the top of the knee cap.

At the discretion of the facilitators and/or managers, we may ask a camper to change or refrain from wearing certain articles if the above standard is not met.
