Spruce Lake Day Camp Parent Agreement

I hereby enroll my child, ______ into Spruce Lake Day Camp with the following understandings:

Spruce Lake Day Camp (SLDC) is a ministry of Spruce Lake Retreat whose mission is "Pointing People toward Christ". Campers will be exposed to Biblical teaching on a regular basis during the camp day. Team members will respect beliefs of individual campers and families.

I give permission for my child to fully participate in all program activities.

Photographs and/or video of my child may be used for publicity purposes.

I give permission for my child to attend field trips run by SLDC and to be transported by approved staff and vehicles.

Rules of conduct for campers, which will provide for a safe and life-enriching camper experience, will be clearly communicated to children and parents. SLDC reserves the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's code of conduct.

Modest dress is required for boys & girls. See parent info for specific guidelines.

Campers are not permitted to carry cell phones or electronics during camp.

The deposit is non-refundable, and there are no daily rates or reductions if a camper does not attend all of the contracted days. No tuition will be returned for the weeks in which a camper is dismissed or withdrawn. Cancellations within two weeks of the registered week of camp are eligible for a refund of 50% of tuition. Cancellations/interruptions on or after the camp start date are not eligible for a refund.

Tuition must be paid by the Wednesday prior to the week of camp your child is attending. Any outstanding balance will be charged to the account on file.

There will be a \$25 fee for all returned insufficient fund checks.

In order for your child to participate in SLDC, a health form must be completed and returned **prior to** attendance.

Only authorized persons (listed on registration form) will be permitted to pick up a camper from camp. Any changes or additions must be communicated to the Day Camp office.

If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept home until they have been symptom free for 24 hours or are cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat), chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections.

The Day Camp office should be contacted if your child will be absent from camp due to illness.

In consideration of the permission granted for my child to participate in Day Camp activities, I hereby release, and covenant with Spruce Lake Day Camp that I will never institute any action at law for any personal injuries, or injuries to property arising out of activities sponsored by Spruce Lake Day Camp.
