Spruce Lake Day Camp Parent Agreement

I hereby attest that I, as parent or legal guardian of the above camper, have read and reviewed this form and have completed it accurately and will report any information that may change. I therefore agree that my child may participate in all camp activities including travel off property.

I understand that Spruce Lake Day Camp is a ministry of Spruce Lake Retreat whose mission is "Pointing People toward Christ". Campers will be exposed to Biblical teaching on a regular basis during the camp day. Team members will respect beliefs of individual campers and families.

I give permission for my child to fully participate in all program activities.

I agree to pay for all services rendered and understand that the card or account on file may be charged automatically for the full balance owed to Spruce Lake.

The <u>Code of Conduct</u> for campers, which will provide for a safe and life-enriching camper experience, will be clearly communicated to children and parents. Spruce Lake reserves the right to dismiss any child who does not cooperate with the program's code of conduct.

Modest dress is required for boys & girls. See parent info for specific guidelines.

Campers are not permitted to carry cell phones or electronics during camp.

Refund Policy:

I understand that the deposit is non-refundable and that there are no daily rates or reductions if a camper does not attend all of the contracted days. No tuition will be returned for the weeks in which a camper is dismissed or withdrawn. Cancellations within two weeks of the registered week of camp are eligible for a refund of 50% of tuition.

Cancellations/interruptions for any reason on or after the camp start date are not eligible for a refund or make-up days.

Tuition must be paid prior to the week of camp your child is attending. Any outstanding balance will be charged to the account on file. There will be a \$25 fee for all returned insufficient fund checks.

In order for your child to participate, a health form must be completed and returned **prior** to attendance.

Only authorized persons will be permitted to pick up a camper from camp. Any changes or additions must be communicated to the camp office.

If your child experiences any of the following conditions, they should be kept home until they have been symptom free for 24 hours or are cleared by a physician: fever greater than 100 degrees, upper respiratory tract infection, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis (pink eye), streptococcal pharyngitis (strep throat), chicken pox, lice or scabies, impetigo or fungal skin infections.

There will be no reductions or refunds for days missed due to illness.

The camp office should be contacted if your child will not attend camp for any reason.

I realize that in the event of an illness or injury while at camp or participating in its activities, medical treatment may be required. I give permission for the medical personnel selected by the camp director to order any medical procedures, including x-rays, routine tests, treatment, hospitalization, and transportation. Furthermore, I agree to bear all the cost of all such treatment.

I also agree to hold harmless Spruce Lake, Franconia Mennonite Camping Association, its successors, and legal representatives from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever may arise due to the participation of me or my child in said activities.

I realize that my camper's image or testimony may be used in promotion of the camp.

I also give consent for Spruce Lake to share spiritual decisions made by the above camper with my designated local church for follow-up as it is the intent of Spruce Lake to connect campers with their local church.
