

## TRUE NORTH ADVENTURE

True North Adventure is a three-day, faith-based, outdoor experience for students. Hosted on our beautiful 10 million dollar campus, True North serves schools and homeschool families or co-ops.

Each NEW cabin boasts a roomy layout with private bathrooms and showers making it easy for your group! Standard cabins sleep 14 guests; smaller duplex cabins sleep 6 in an accessible format.

With the exception of family groups, cabins are assigned to same gender individuals from the same school/organization. For each gender, groups will be assessed a cabin rate (standard or duplex) as well as a \$166 fee for each participant over the cabin occupancy. Additional cabins and spaces are available for overflow housing.

### Rate Example:

School A has a group of 16 ladies and 18 gentlemen. They will pay the Standard Cabin rate of \$2,335 for 2 cabins (1 per gender) and an additional \$166 fee for 2 ladies and 4 gentlemen resulting in a total bill of \$5,666 or approximately \$166/person.
